

Results – pre-1972 Olympic Games

Archery events were contested at the Olympic Games in 1900, 1904, 1908 and 1920.

1900: The events took place during national and international competitions organized on the occasion of the World Exhibition in Paris. 4698 archers were recorded over a period of more than three months. Only French, a few Dutch and numerous Belgians took part in these competitions. Six of the many events were considered as Olympic.
